PERMIT CONDITIONS:

1. Burning Permit is at the burn site and available for inspection.
2. Burning is conducted on the property where the burned material originated
3. Burning is conducted on sunny days between 9:00a.m. and 3:00p.m.
4. Burning must not be conducted when wind speed is above 10 miles per hour and/or there is an inversion condition
5. Burning is not conducted within 30 ft of a building
6. Burning is not conducted on public property, roads, alleys, or sidewalks
7. Burning is supervised by a person over the age of 18 until the fire is extinguished
8. A fire extinguisher or garden hose/water is within 10ft of the fire and available.
9. Only clean dry materials are burned. Burning that is hazardous, offensive or objectionable is prohibited.
10. That it is the sole responsibility of the individual conducting the burning to satisfactorily determine that all conditions permitting burning as noted above are met during any given period when he or she conducts a burning authorized by a Village of Elburn permit.
11. Additional special conditions _____

Failure to meet the above listed conditions voids this permit and subjects permittee to other provisions of law.
